**Notes on statistics**

Statistical terms used are mainly measures of appropriateness, the reliability of the method.

**Latent variables:** These are unobserved variables derived from measured (observed) variables.

**Dimension:** Factor analysis as a data reduction technique can lead to one latent variable indicating unidimensionality or several latent variables indicating multidimensionality.

**Correlation:** An association between variables. When the association is strong, they have high correlation, when low, they have low correlation. The measure of correlation, the correlation coefficient, ranges from -1.0 to +1.0. Zero is no relationship, closer to 1 indicates a strong positive relationship (as one rises, the other rises) and closer to minus 1 indicates a negative relationship (as one rises, the other falls). Pearson's correlation coefficient measures the relationship. Other measures are Kendall and Spearman.

**Communalities:** The extent to which a variable associates with others in the analysis, belongingness to the community of variables.

**Variance:** A measure of how much the numbers of a set are spread out from each other, how far they are from the average. The explained variance is a measure of how much the analysis can account for out of the total variance. It is about the goodness of the predictive value of the analysis.

**SPSS functions:** Promax oblique rotation, orthogonal rotation and maximum likelihood are statistical functions used to define the type of factor analysis required and are informed by the characteristics of the data.

**Statistical measures of appropriateness of the analysis:** Determinant, Kaiser–Meyer–Olkin Measure of Sampling Adequacy, Cronbach alpha are all measures indicating the appropriateness of the analysis. All the numbers fall within specified ranges.
